6.8 Green Thumb

General

Finally we have reached the point where we are returning our produce to our school community. This term we have:

- Supplied celery and Lettuce to the school canteen
- Provided fresh leafy veggies and herbs for parents to take at school pick up. An optional donation jar is provided, and around \$10 has been collected over the three weeks. However the main thing is that the garden is being enjoyed by our school families and staff.
- The tank pump has been fixed, and the main tap on the trough has been changed over to mains water.

Proposals for further work (see previous reports, for more detailed list):

- Concrete slabs are now being sourced to provide a base for the small garden shed to be installed. This should be completed in the next few weeks.
- The bottle tops have been given to our art teacher who will be using them in art works around our garden.
- Projects to decorate the fence continue.
- We are planning to replace the 'lab' tap on the trough with a spring loaded raised tap so that water cannot be left on and wasted.

Gardening activities

Spring crops are being harvested. The for the rest of the term we will plant some 'quick crops' and at the end of the year a working bee will be scheduled to clear out the garden beds and plant green manure for the summer break. Also the tap has been fixed.

Finance and Fundraising

Instruments
